RICKY RUBIO- THE BEST POINT GUARD OF SPAIN

Yesterday we interviewed the medal winner Ricky Rubio, who got the bronze in basketball. Here's what he told us.

When, we asked him how long he had been playing professional basketball, he said that he had played professional basketball since he was 14 years old.

Then we asked him why he started and where he usually played basketball. He started playing basketball because his father was a trainer of a team in Mataró. And he usually played in Phoenix with his team The Phoenix Suns.

Then, we asked him how often he trained, and he answered that he usually trained two times a week and he played three matches per week.

Finally, we asked him how he felt after winning the bronze and what he would do with the medal. He said he felt so happy and that he would probably put the medal in his personal museum of awards.

How long have you been playing professional basketball?

I have played professional basketball since I was 14 years old.

Why did you start?

Because my father trained a team in Mataró and I went with him to training.

Where did you usually play basketball?

In Phoenix with my team the Phoenix Suns or in my house with my own basketball equipment.

How often do you train?

I usually train two times a week and I play three matches per week.

How do you feel after winning the bronze?

I feel so happy because I need this medal. This medal is so especial because the award for a whole summer of work.

What will you do with the medal?

I will probably put it in my personal museum of awards.

RICKY RUBIO



Ricky Rubio is one of the best basketball players in the history of Spain. Also he is one of the best Spanish player to have played in the NBA.

Ricky Rubio was born in 1990 in El Masnou, Spain. When he was 4 years old he began to play in the team whose father coached. When he was 14 years old he became the youngest player to debut in the Liga ACB. In 2011 Ricky Rubio went to the NBA. In december of this year Ricky debuted with the Minesota Timberwolves. In 2017 he signed by the Utah Jazz and in 2019 he signed by the Phoenix Suns.

To end this biography I am going to said his honors. He has won 1 ACB, 1 Eurocup, 1 Euroleague, 2 Eurobaskets and 1 World Cup. He has 1 bronze medal in Olimpics Games and 1 silver medal. He has more titles but it would take me all day listing them. This is the M.V.P. of the World Cup Ricky Rubio.
